



ISSUANCE OF AN INTERNATIONAL DRIVING LICENCE

An international driving licence is issued to a national driving licence holder when travelling abroad on the base of a written request.

There are two types to be issued: under the Convention on Road Traffic / Vienna 1968/ : under the Convention on Road Traffic /Geneva 1949/

The applicant personally files an application and along with it he/she submits:

- a valid ID card with a photograph from which it is possible to verify a place of permanent residence
- a valid driving licence
- a photograph sized 3,5 x 4,5 cm corresponding with the applicant's appearance at the time of filing the application and the applicant is displayed in the front side look with a height of the face part of the head from the eyes to the chin minimally of 13 mm, in formal clothes without sunglasses or a cover of the head

The application is subject to a charge of 50 CZK (under the Act No. 634/2004 Coll., of administrative charges) and is payable on application.
